LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- Updating and retraining the staff employed in the public institutions, in the schools and in the social, socio-medical and socio-cultural services;
- Training and updating lawyers and legal professionals on complex questions related to the migration law.

The II Level Master Degree in "Migration Law" is in collaboration with **OIM (International Organization for Migration)**, **ICMC (International Catholic Migration Commission)** e **CIR (The Italian Refugee Council)**.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

LESSON PLAN

The **LESSON PLAN** is divided in three areas:

- AREA OF LEGAL STUDIES (220 hours)
- AREA OF ECONOMIC STUDIES (80 hours)
- AREA OF SOCIAL STUDIES (80 hours)

The AREA OF LEGAL STUDIES includes the following didactic teaching:

- **ITALIAN AND EUROPEAN CONSTITUTIONAL LAW** (Module 1 Italian Constitutional Law and immigration; Module 2 European Union Law and immigration);
- **INTERNATIONAL LAW AND INTERNATIONAL CRIMINAL LAW** (Module 1 International Law and immigration; Module 2 Profiles on International Law in the perspective of Human Rights);
- **INSTITUTIONS OF COMPARATIVE LAW** (Module 1 Public Comparative Law and Immigration; Module 2 Private Comparative Law);
- **MIGRATION LAW IN ITALY** (Module 1 Regulations about entry, residence and removal from the territory of the State; Module 2 Law, immigration and Labor; Module 3 Migration Criminal Law);
- **SOCIAL INTEGRATION, MEASURES AGAINST DISCRIMINATION** (Module 1 Social integration measures; Module 2 Discrimination motivated by race, ethnicity, nationality and religion);
- **ASYLUM LAW** (Module 1 Asylum Law in the Italian Legal System; Module 2 Refugees status);
- **FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS: THE EXERCISE OF FREEDOM OF THOUGHT, CONSCIENCE, RELIGION** (Module 1 The freedom of religion in the International Treaties and in the European Law; Module 2 The freedom of religion in the Constitution and in the National Law).

The AREA OF ECONOMIC SCIENCES includes the following didactic teaching:

- **MIGRATION AND SOCIO-ECONOMIC PROCESSES** (Module 1 The structural context; Module 2 Socio-economic processes and migration);
